3. Scholarship award amounts and number awarded will be based on funds available.
4. Scholarship funds will be sent to awardees following successful completion of the semester of study.
5. Recipients must demonstrate satisfactory progress toward a degree or certificate and submit a copy of their first semester transcript (official or unofficial) to the address below to receive their scholarship check.
